Exercise 2 - Speedy Note Entry

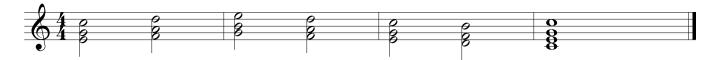
Re-create the following musical example using the Speedy Note Entry tool.
