

Name of Instrument : Trumpet



Use in Ensemble : soprano. Great solo instrument.

Parts of Instrument :

Response Problems : Pianissimo is difficult to control in extreme registers. Upper register should not be approached by leap. High range is easiest when loud. "lead into" notes in the upper register - avoid entrances on a high note.

Intonation Problems : All valve combination. High and low registers.

Fingering Problems :

Other Comments :

(1) Construction: Primarily cylindrical. 2/3 - 1/3 conical.

(2) Most agile of all the brasses.

(3) In general, when writing for the trumpet, stay in the staff.
