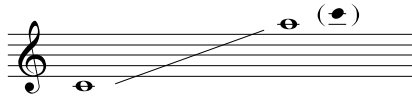


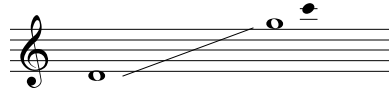

Name of Instrument : Alto Flute

Range

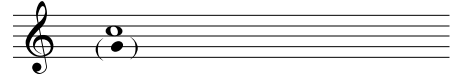


Most Used Range (written)

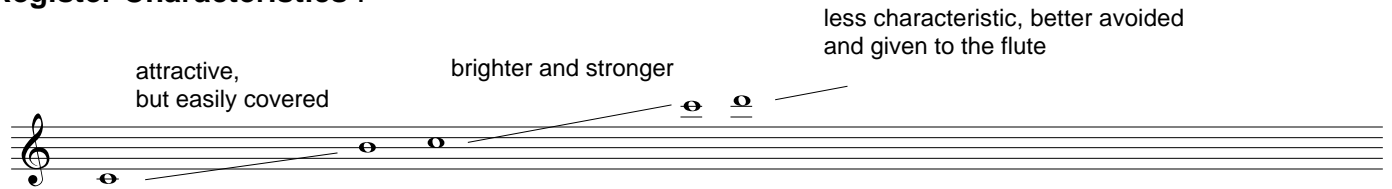


Transposition

Sounds down a perfect 4th



Register Characteristics :



Use in Ensemble : Alto voice in a small ensemble. Best used as a solo instrument with a light, thin accompaniment.

Parts of Instrument : head joint, body, footjoint

Response Problems : Not as agile as the flute or piccolo. Because of its size, it requires more breath.

Intonation Problems : Middle register

Fingering Problems :

Other Comments :

- (1) Not a common member of the ensemble. It is usually an addition. Not frequently found in high school groups.
- (2) Low register can be easily covered -use light scoring.
- (3) Beware special effects. Ask the player what they can do.
