


INSTRUMENTAL CHECKLIST

Name of Instrument: Bass Clarinet



Register Characteristics:



Use in Ensemble: Doubles bass and tenor well.

Parts of Instrument: mouthpiece, barrell, upper joint, lower joint, bell

Response Problems: Upper register is thin, and difficult for the player. Staccato is less incisive than double reeds and flutes. Low Eb and C should probably be written for professionals only.

Intonation Problems: High register is risky.

Fingering Problems : The break.

Other Comments:

- (1) Overblows at the 12th.
- (2) Dynamic control is exceptionally good.
- (3) Common special effects: glissandi, multiphonics, sub-tone, trills.
- (4) Not very agile but does have the expressive ability of the clarinets.
