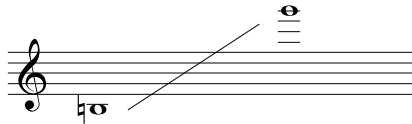


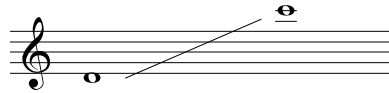

Name of Instrument : English Horn

Range

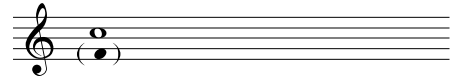


Most Used Range (written)

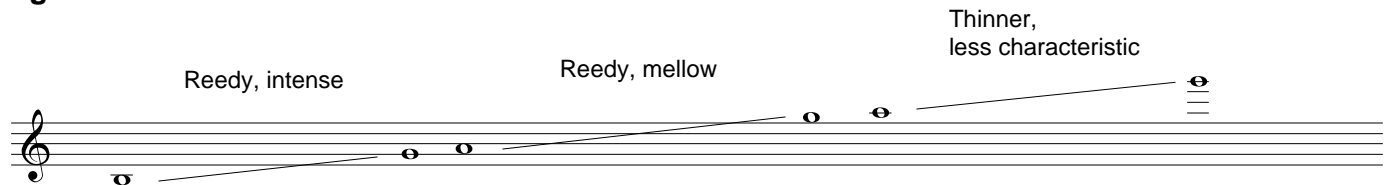


Transposition

Sounds down a perfect 5th



Register Characteristics :



Use in Ensemble : Middle voice. Great for solo passages.

Parts of Instrument : Reed, bocal, upper joint, lower joint, bell.

Response Problems : Soft attacks in the low register. Be careful of the break.

Intonation Problems : Break area.

Fingering Problems : Be careful of the break.

Other Comments :

- (1) Common special effects: trills, multiphonics.
- (2) Do not use for fast, complicated passages for it is not very agile.
- (3) The low register is most effective.
