
ASU - Instrumentation/Arranging Fall 1999 Dr. Crist INSTRUMENTAL CHECKLIST

Name of Instrument : Piccolo



Use in Ensemble : Colors the soprano voice by adding an "edge" or brilliance an octave higher.

Parts of Instrument : head joint, body.

Response Problems : avoid soft attacks in the upper register.

Intonation Problems : The low register tends to be sharp. The upper register tends to be flat.

Fingering Problems : upper register primarily.

Other Comments :

 (1) Common special efftecs include: fluttertongue trills, double and triple tonguing.
(2) Very agile.
(3) Use sparingly as the tone color gets old rather quickly.
