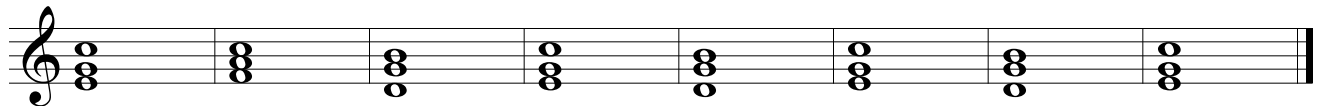


Introduction to Writing Harmonic Progressions

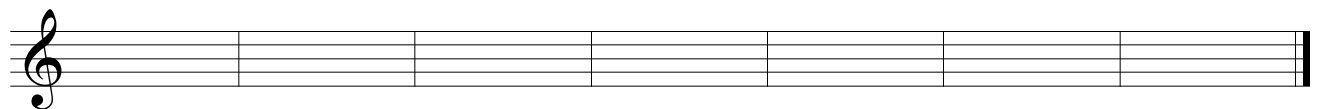

When writing the progression, connect the notes of the chords so that there is minimal movement without introducing parallel fifths.

Example: I IV ___ I V ___ V I

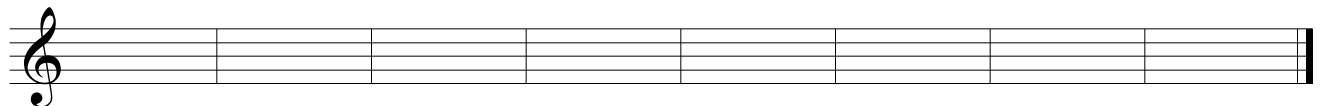
Possible Answer: I IV (V) I V (I) V I



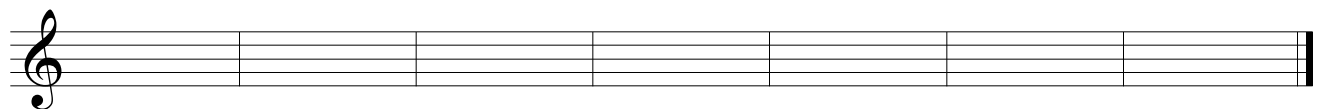
